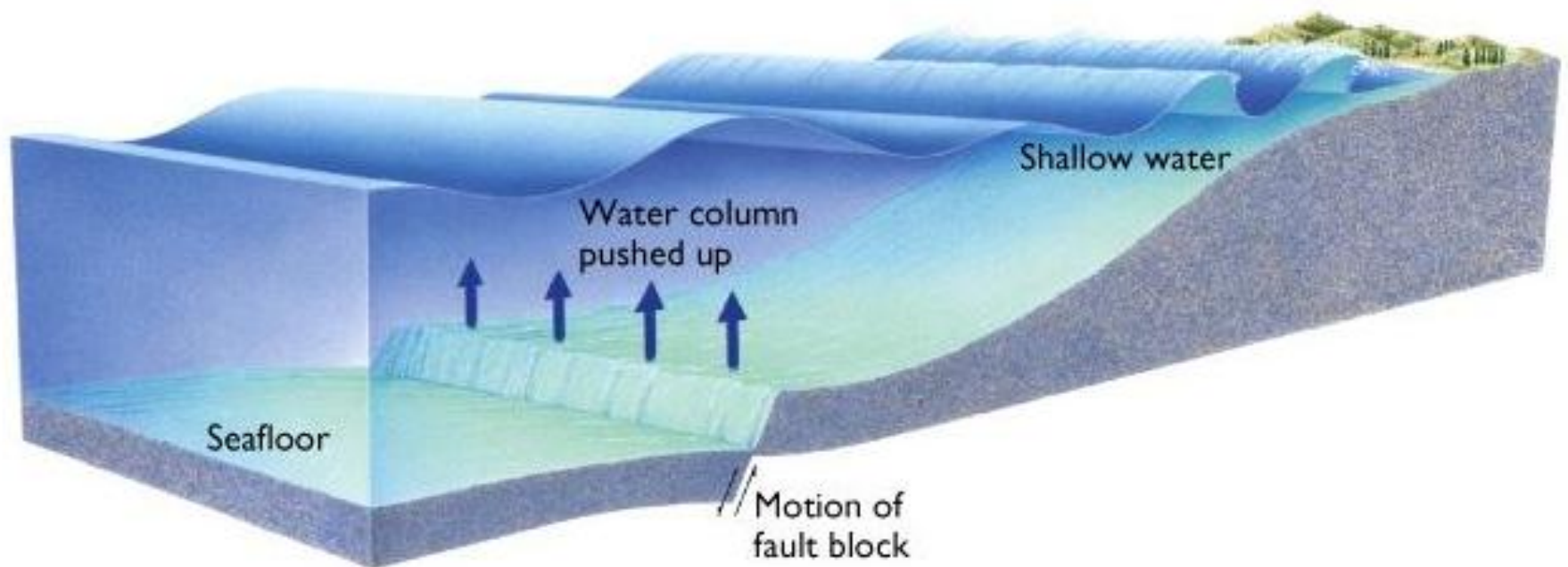
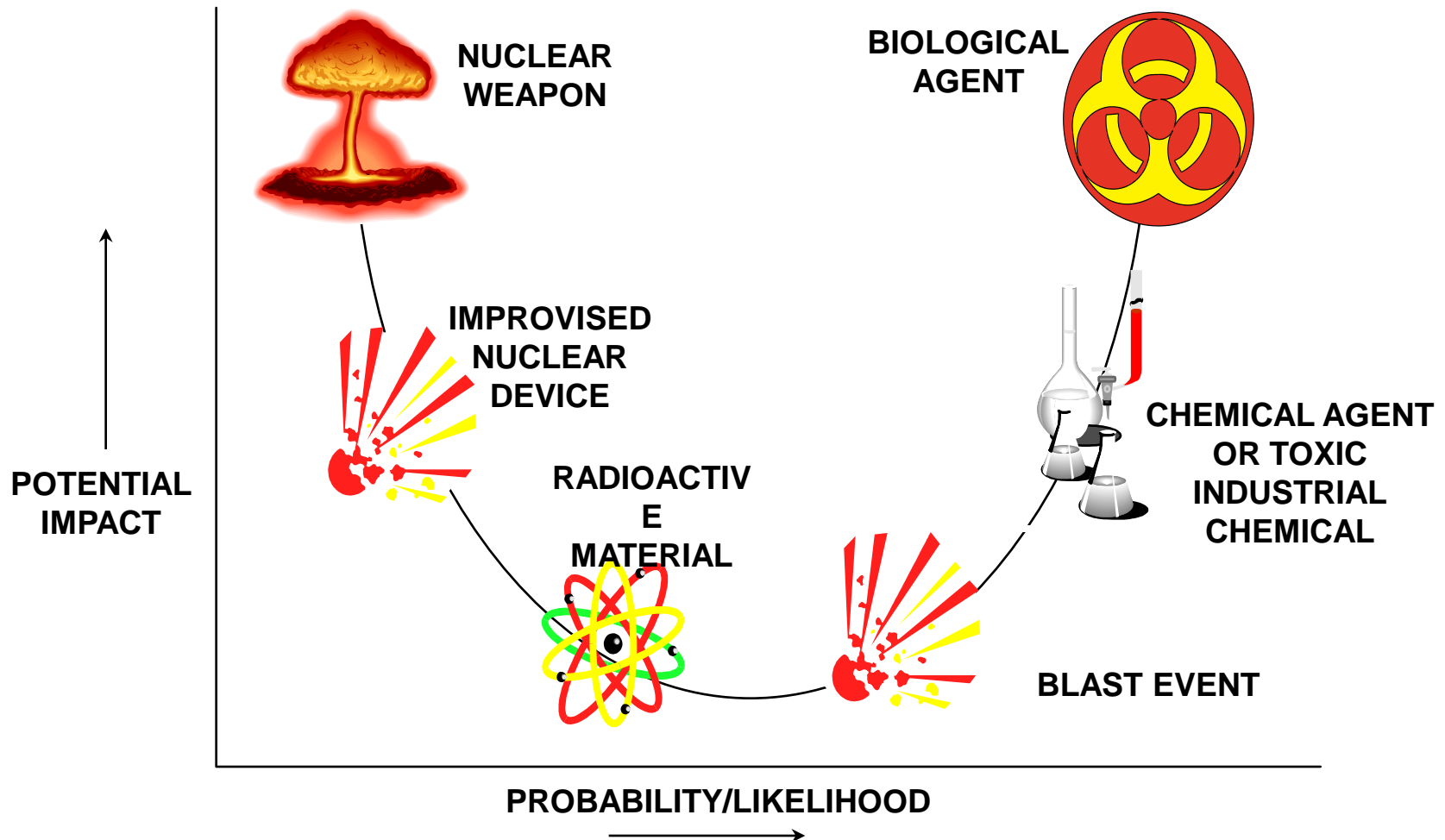

Manmade Disaster : Potential Probability vs. Impact



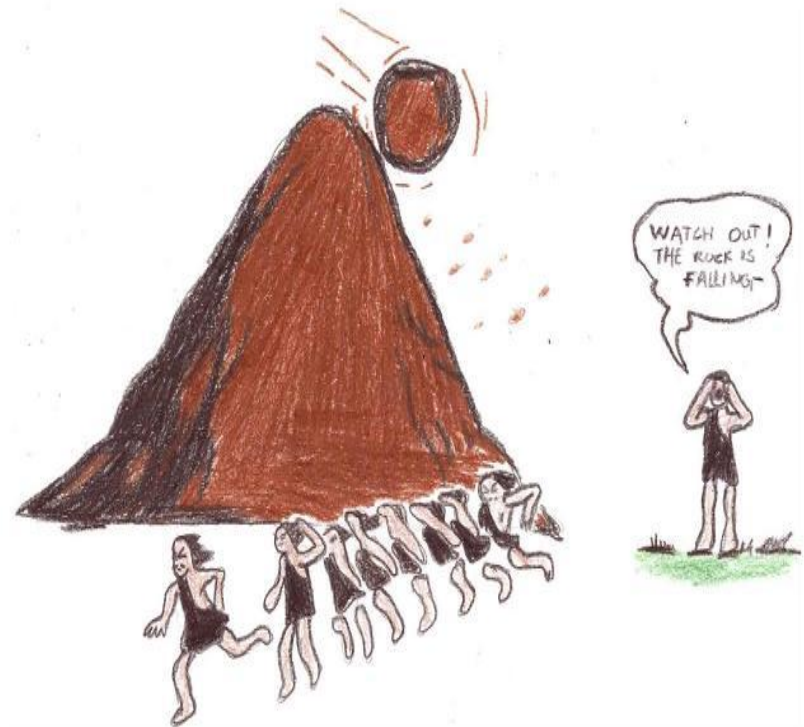


PREPAREDNESS

Reinforcement of capacity to respond

- **Training** : search and rescue teams, provision of material and equipment, organisation of simulation exercises, ...

- **Awareness** campaigns with the population to recognise disaster risks & necessary measures.

Improvement of decision making and reduction of vulnerabilities at a more global level: Includes:

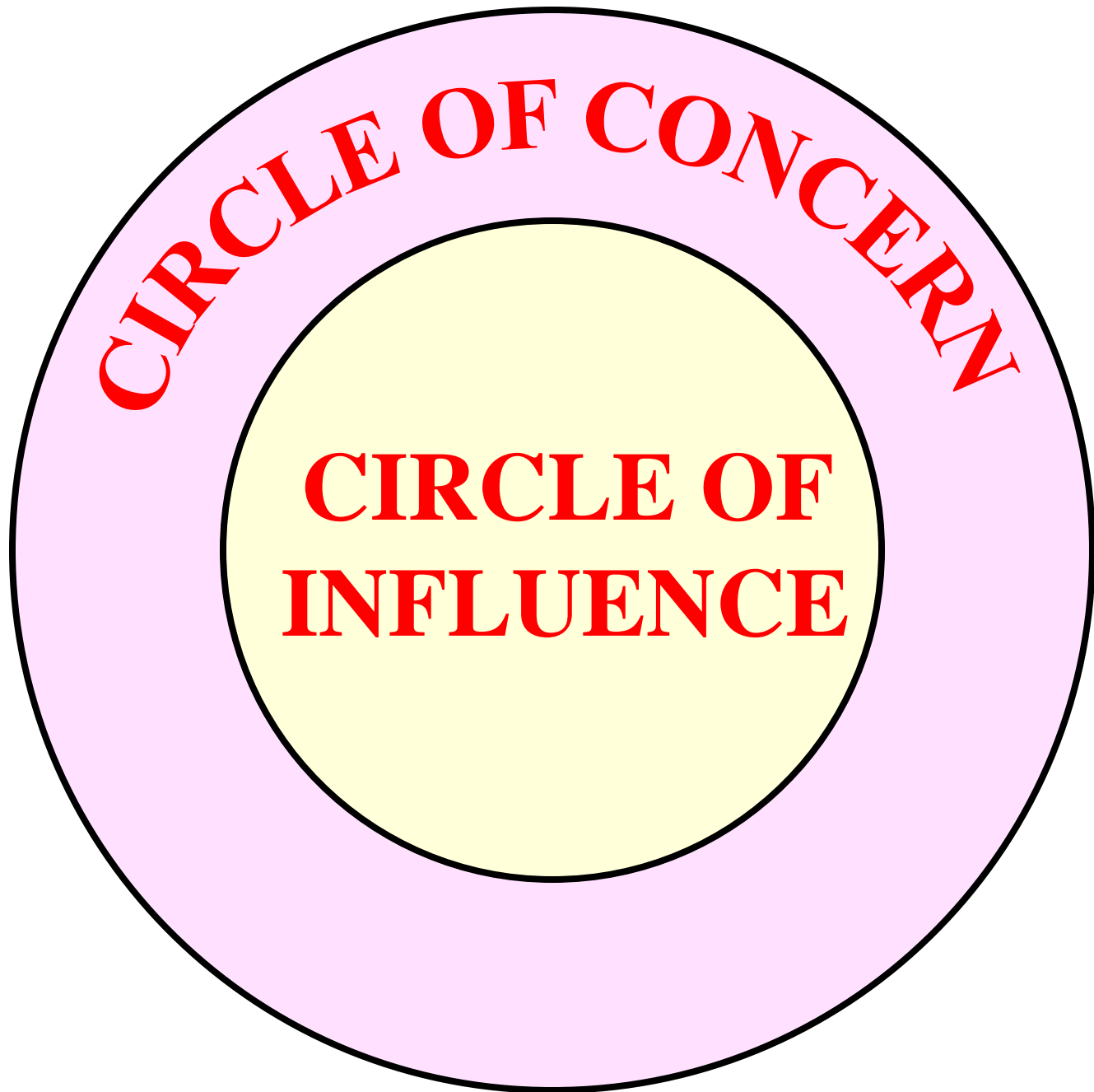
- planning (i.e site planning)

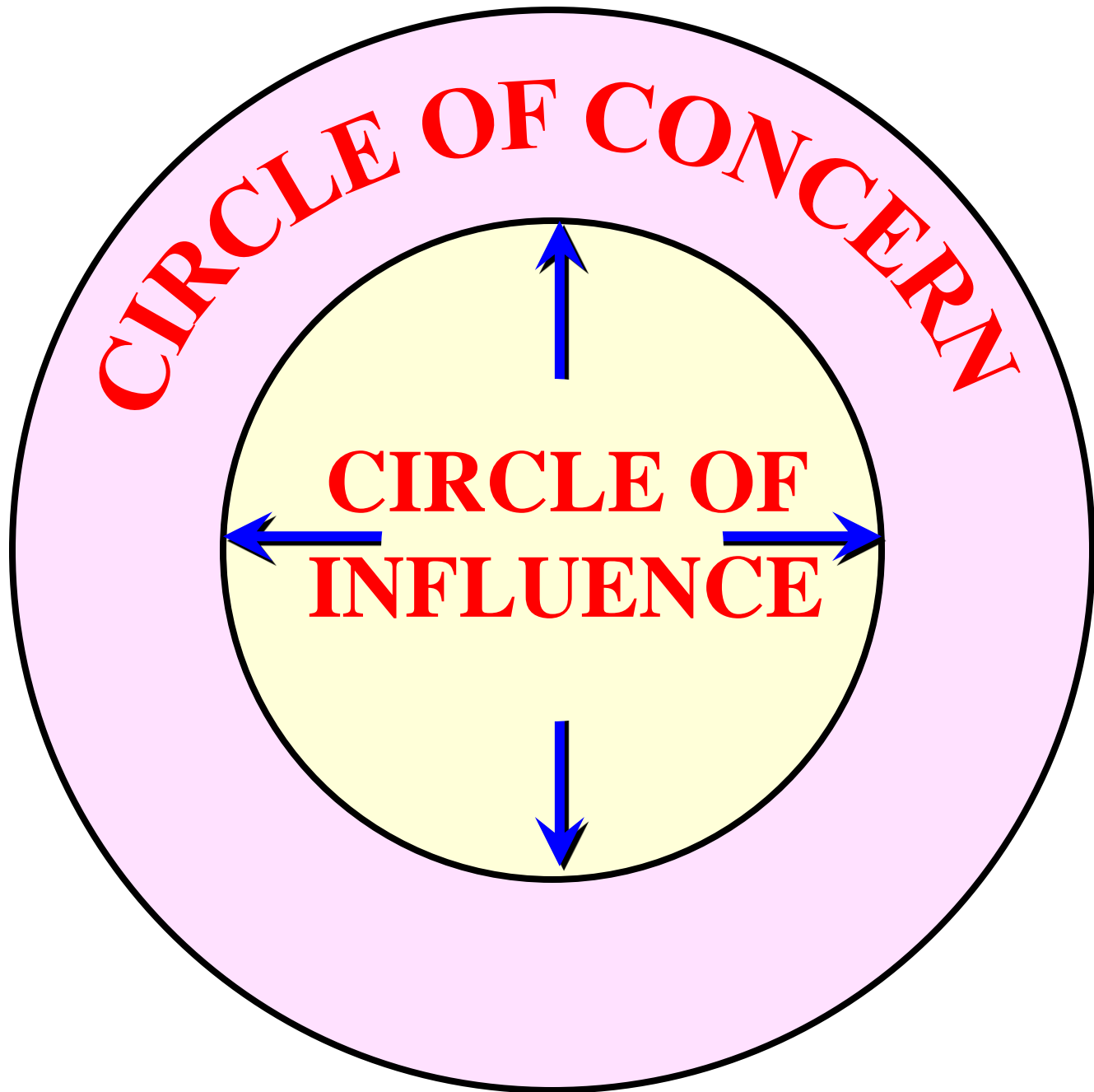

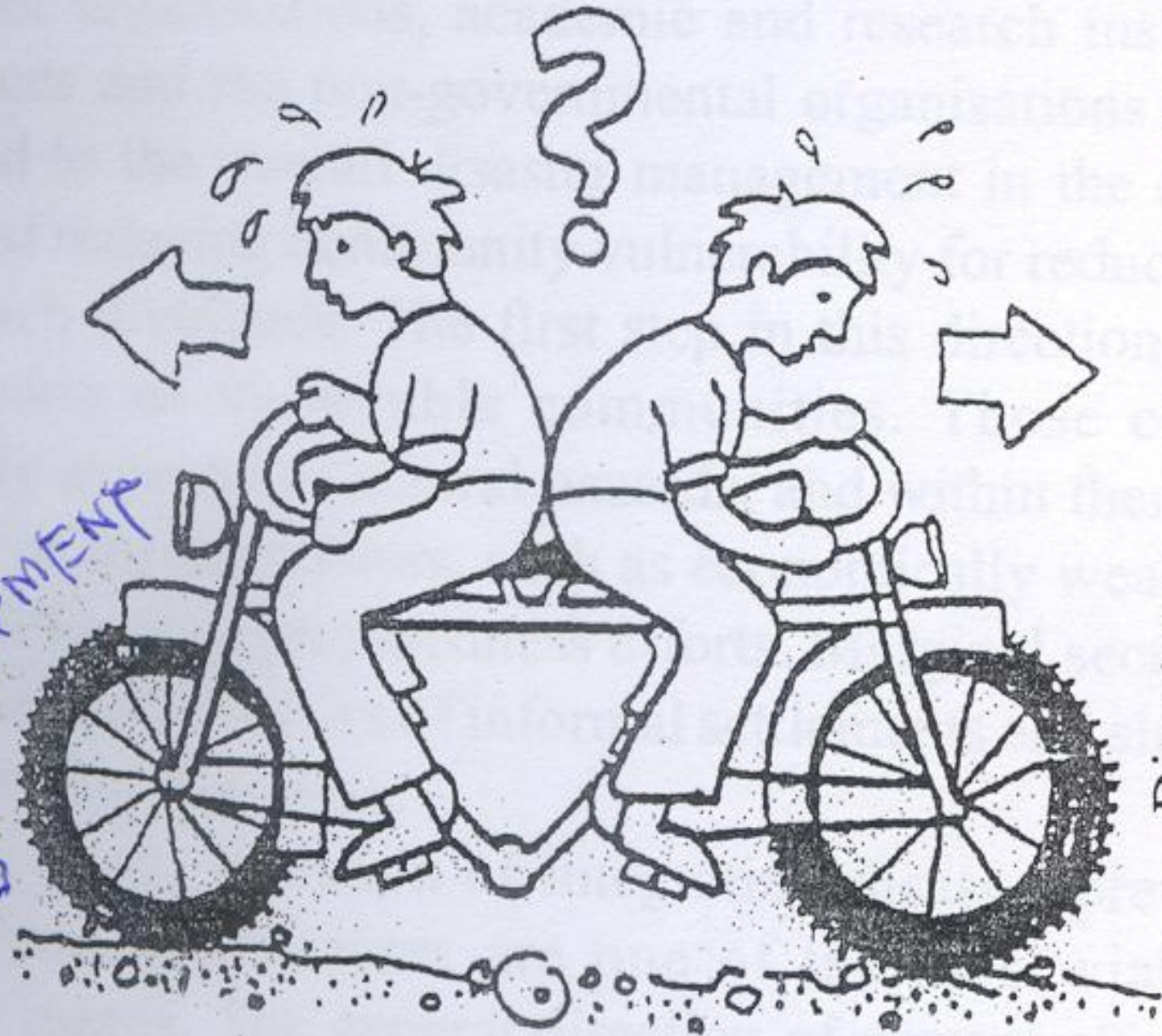
